

Minutes from Transition Liverpool meeting – 07.02.10 at Domino Gallery

Present: Mark Shooter, Margaret Smith, Peter Grant, Cathy, FW

MSh: DCLP (Dingle Learning Community Programme) opening: building and local community TL is to have offices there. It is off Mill Street near the Florrie.

PG made a suggestion re raising awareness of TL and its' raison d'être - Get a statement/tagline which explains the philosophy/principles of the transition movement. MS will send out an email asking for suggestions for this tagline. MSm: Gave an explanation of the TL project and GNET.

There followed a discussion re cashflow in the light of the fact that we will have to pay for the office space at DCLP (£100 per month £27 per week) As we do not have the money to pay for this at the moment she suggested we ask if we can have perhaps three months rent free until we can raise the money?

We would like to create a Liverpool CAT.

PG suggested a Transition Day in Liverpool. And also that we consider speaking to Roger Phillips on Radio Merseyside - this would help to publicise the films at the Meeting House etc.

The words empowerment and mobilisation came up and two suggestions - PG "Changing things for the good" and MSm "From consumer to citizen"

We discussed the possibility of looking at a donation scheme.

MSh outlined the GNET feasibility study.

He then explained Mar Jackson's Training for Transition project.

It was agreed we should have a skills audit of members. MSh "Just for the love of it" - skills bank/exchange.

MSm: Mentioned a Carbon Conversation training proposal for Liverpool - sent out to Transition Southport, Warrington and Chester as well.

It was also suggested we might set up a TL Facebook group?
